INCOME TAX FEATURES

- Setup Wizard records aircraft tax ownership structure
- Primary Purpose Reporting (for individually-owned aircraft)
- SIFL Calculations

- Compiles all information required by IRS regulations to substantiate business use

SIMPLE "INPUT-ONCE" FLIGHT ENTRY SYSTEM

- Flight Entry Screen organized for rapid and simple entry of flight information
- Select aircraft, enter dates, airport-pairs, passengers, flight classification, and purpose of flight
- More than 30,000 world-wide airports in database
- Employee and passenger entry screen to add their data
- Select Business, NBNE, or Entertainment classification for each passenger
- Control person need not be on board
- Allows for flight reimbursement, such as Timesharing and Schwab Reinterpretation
- Flight log tracks flights
- Resembles pilot's log book
- Sort flights in ascending or descending order

STANDARD INDUSTRY FARE LEVEL (SIFL) REPORTING

- Calculates point-to-point SIFL distances
- Applies control and non-control employee rates
- Ignores deadhead legs
- Automatically detects 50% seating capacity
- Meets spousal-travel rules
- Recognizes children under 2 years of age
- Includes +7 day international business flight rules
- Bona fide security plan reporting available

FEDERAL EXCISE TAX (FET) REPORTING

- Includes all Domestic and International FET rules, including 225 mile, Hawaii and Alaska rates, rural airport and 6,000# MTOW exclusions, and others
- Bills FET by assigned aircraft rate for Schwab or Timesharing Flights
- Bills FET by pricing assigned to a specific flight (charter operators)
- Aggregates FET collections by IRS deposit period
- Calculates IRS fuel tax credits
- Quarterly Form 720: Prepares tax and credit amounts by FET tax return line numbers

DATA IMPORT FEATURE

COST DISALLOWANCE REPORTING

 - Flight-By-Flight Hours
- Deadhead flight reporting
- Timeshare flights
- Separate reporting treatment for employees vs. non-employees
- Schwab flights

SEC REPORTING

COST CENTER REPORTING
